IN THE PARK

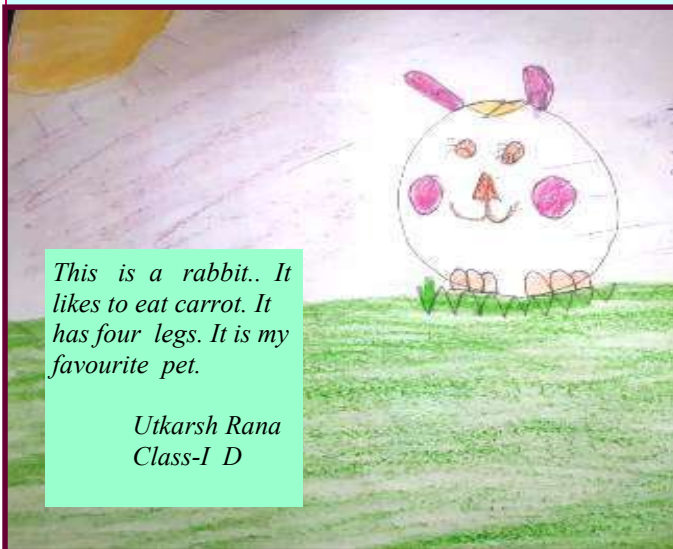
